NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN**, that there will be a **PUBLIC HEARING** before the **VILLAGE PLAN COMMISSION** of the **VILLAGE OF PLEASANT PRAIRIE**, Kenosha County, Wisconsin, at the Village Municipal Building, 9915 39<sup>th</sup> Avenue, on the **14<sup>th</sup> day of December, 2009** on or after 5:00 p.m., to consider Chapter 390 of the Village Municipal Code entitled "Comprehensive Plan" and to adopt the "Village of Pleasant Prairie, Wisconsin 2035 Comprehensive Plan".

The public hearing concerning the Comprehensive Plan follows months of collaborative work by the Village, Kenosha County, UW-Extension and the Southeastern Regional Planning Commission. The Plan addresses the nine (9) elements in accordance with Section 66.1001 of the Wisconsin Statutes. The Plan also includes numerous maps, tables, figures, appendices, goals, objectives, policies and recommendations to guide development in the Village to the year 2035. Subsequent to the public hearing, the Village Board will consider an ordinance to formally adopt the Plan.
