

**VILLAGE OF PLEASANT PRAIRIE
NOTICE OF ADOPTION**

On June 4, 2012 the Village of Pleasant Prairie Board of Trustees adopted Ordinance #12-19 related to amendments to the Village Floodplain Zoning Ordinance (Section 420-131 of the Village Zoning Ordinance) to meet the minimum federal and State requirements and to adopt the revised Flood Insurance Study (FIS) and Flood Insurance Rate Map (FIRM) prepared by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) for the Village. The new FIRM Maps incorporate the Des Plaines River Watershed floodplains adopted by the Village in 1998 and other floodplain boundary amendments approved by the Village, the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources and FEMA since the last FIRM Maps were prepared for the Village and dated December 5, 1996.

A copy of the Ordinance #12-19 and the reference floodplain maps and studies can be viewed at the Pleasant Prairie Village Hall, 9915 39th Avenue, Pleasant Prairie during normal business hours.
