**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN**, that there will be **PUBLIC HEARING** before the **VILLAGE PLAN COMMISSION of the VILLAGE OF PLEASANT PRAIRIE**, Kenosha County, Wisconsin, at the Village Municipal Building, 9915 39th Avenue on the **26<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2015** on or after 6:00 P.M. of said day, to consider the request of Attorney J. Michael McTernan agent for VIDHYA Corp, VIII, Inc., the property owners, for an **Amendment to Conditional Use Permit #13-03 as amended on January 13, 2014 and June 9, 2014**. The petitioners are requesting to remove condition #54 and allow the BP Amoco gasoline station and convenience store located at 10477 120<sup>th</sup> Avenue to remain open after June 10, 2015 subject to the terms and conditions of the existing Conditional Use Permit and the Settlement Agreement between the Village and the property owners.
