NOTICE OF A PUBLIC HEARING**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN**, that there will be a **PUBLIC HEARING** before the **VILLAGE PLAN COMMISSION** of the **VILLAGE OF PLEASANT PRAIRIE**, Kenosha County, Wisconsin, at the Village Municipal Building Auditorium, 9915 39<sup>th</sup> Avenue on the **16<sup>th</sup> day of July, 2012** at 5:00 p.m. of said day, to consider the suspension or revocation of the Conditional Use Permit # 01-11 that was approved by the Village Plan Commission on June 25, 2001 that allows BP Amoco to operate the gasoline station and convenience store located at 10477 120<sup>th</sup> Avenue. This hearing specifically relates to the written complaint filed by the Village Zoning Administrator regarding BP Amoco's noncompliance with the terms of said Conditional Use Permit and the violation of Village Ordinance Section 420-145 G., as it relates to "standards for conditional uses" and specifically Section 420-38 D., Water Quality Protection performance standards.

The subject property is known as Lot 14 of CSM 1489 located in a part of the Northwest One-Quarter of U.S. Public Land Survey Section 30, Township 1 North, Range 22 East of the Fourth Principal Meridian, lying and being in the Village of Pleasant Prairie, County of Kenosha, State of Wisconsin and further identified as Tax Parcel Number 92-4-122-302-0130.
