NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that there will be a **PUBLIC HEARING** before the **VILLAGE PLAN COMMISSION** of the **VILLAGE OF PLEASANT PRAIRIE**, Kenosha County, Wisconsin, at the Village Municipal Building, 9915 39th Avenue, on the **12th day of September, 2011** on or after **6:00 p.m.**, to consider an Amendment to the Village of Pleasant Prairie, Wisconsin 2035 Comprehensive Plan pursuant to Chapter 390 of the Village Code of Ordinances.

The public hearing is being held to consider the adoption of the update to the 1981 Kenosha County Farmland Preservation Plan as a component of the Village's Comprehensive Plan and to create Section 390-6 E to specifically list this Plan as a component of the Village's Comprehensive Plan. Subsequent to the public hearing, the Village Board will consider said Ordinance to formally adopt the update to the 1981 Kenosha County Farmland Preservation Plan.
