

**VILLAGE OF PLEASANT PRAIRIE  
NOTICE OF A PUBLIC HEARING**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN**, that there will be a **PUBLIC HEARING** before the **VILLAGE PLAN COMMISSION** of the **VILLAGE OF PLEASANT PRAIRIE**, Kenosha County, Wisconsin, at the Village Municipal Building, 9915 39<sup>th</sup> Avenue, on the **8<sup>th</sup> day of October, 2012** on or after **6:00 p.m.**, to consider the following amendments to the Village of Pleasant Prairie, Wisconsin 2035 Comprehensive Plan for the request of Adam Artz P.E. of Pinnacle Engineering on behalf of Majestic Realty Co: **1)** to amend a portion of the Pleasant Farms Neighborhood Plan to relocate the proposed future high school site to the west; and **2)** to amend a portion of the Village of Pleasant Prairie 2035 Comprehensive Land Use Plan Map 9.9 to reflect the proposed location change of the future high school site; and **3)** to update Appendix 10-3 of the Village of Pleasant Prairie Wisconsin, 2035 Comprehensive Plan to include said amendment.

The Pleasant Farms Neighborhood area proposed to be amended is generally located west of 88<sup>th</sup> Avenue (CTH H) south of Bain Station Road, west of 104<sup>th</sup> Avenue and north of Prairie Springs Park located within U.S. Public Land Survey Sections 17, 18 and 20, Township 1 North, Range 22 East in the Village of Pleasant Prairie, Kenosha County, Wisconsin.

A copy of the proposed amendments are available for review at the Village Municipal Building between 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., Monday - Friday (except holidays).

Comments on the proposed amendment will be received prior to and at the public hearing.
