

**VILLAGE OF PLEASANT PRAIRIE
NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that there will be a **PUBLIC HEARING** before the **VILLAGE PLAN COMMISSION** of the **VILLAGE OF PLEASANT PRAIRIE**, Kenosha County, Wisconsin, at the Village Municipal Building, 9915 39th Avenue, on the **10th day of September, 2012** on or after **6:00 p.m.**, to consider amendments to the Village of Pleasant Prairie, Wisconsin 2035 Comprehensive Plan pursuant to Chapter 390 of the Village Code of Ordinances.

The public hearing is being held to consider the adoption of the Amendment to the Regional Water Quality Management Plan Greater Kenosha Area adopted by the Southeastern Wisconsin Regional Planning Commission in June 2012 as a component of the Village's Comprehensive Plan and to create Section 390-6 F to specifically list this Plan as a component of the Village's Comprehensive Plan. In addition, to add a notation to the following Maps within the Comprehensive Plan to reference the adoption of said amendment: 1) Map 5.1 entitled "2010 Pleasant Prairie Sewer Utility District and Lake Michigan Sewer Utility District Boundaries"; 2) Map 5.2 entitled "Detailed Adopted Sanitary Sewer Service Areas within the Pleasant Prairie Sewer Utility District"; and 3) Map 5.3 entitled "Generalized Adopted Sanitary Sewer Service Areas and Existing Areas Served by Sewer".

Subsequent to the public hearing, the Village Board will consider said Ordinance to formally adopt the Amendment to the Regional Water Quality Management Plan Greater Kenosha Area.

A copy of the Plan amendment is available for review at the Village Municipal Building between 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., Monday - Friday (except Holidays) or on the Village website at www.pleasantprairieonline.com.

If you wish to comment on the Plan, comments will be received prior to and at the public hearing. Written comments shall be sent directly to Jean Werbie-Harris, Community Development Director at the Village Municipal Building at the address above.
