FOR A CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN**, that there will be a **PUBLIC HEARING** before the **VILLAGE PLAN COMMISSION of the VILLAGE OF PLEASANT PRAIRIE**, Kenosha County, Wisconsin, at the Village Municipal Building, 9915 39<sup>th</sup> Avenue on the **9<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2008** on or after 5:00 P.M. of said day, to consider the following:

The Village of Pleasant Prairie will be conducting a **Public Hearing** for the request of John Hickey of Black & Veatch, agent, on behalf of Cricket Communications, for a **Conditional Use Permit** to co-locate three (3) antennas upon the existing 180 foot high monopole tower and to construct an associated 10' x 16' equipment shelter at the tower base on Village owned property located at the southeast corner of 104<sup>th</sup> Street and Sheridan Road.

The subject property is addressed as 10415 Sheridan Road and is improved with a Village Water Reservoir and Booster Station and is located in a part of the Northeast One-Quarter of U.S. Public Land Survey Section 30, Township 1 North, Range 23 East of the Fourth Principal Meridian, lying and being in the Village of Pleasant Prairie, Kenosha County, Wisconsin and further identified as Tax Parcel Number 93-4-123-301-0901.
