NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
FOR A CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that there will be a **PUBLIC HEARING** before the **VILLAGE PLAN COMMISSION of the VILLAGE OF PLEASANT PRAIRIE**, Kenosha County, Wisconsin, at the Village Municipal Building, 9915 39th Avenue on the **9th day of June, 2008** on or after 5:00 P.M. of said day, to consider the following:

The Village of Pleasant Prairie will be conducting a **Public Hearing** for the request of John Hickey of Black & Veatch, agent, on behalf of Cricket Communications, for a **Conditional Use Permit** to co-locate six (6) antennas atop the existing 125 foot high Village Water Tower and to construct an associated 10' x 16' equipment shelter at the tower base on Village owned property generally located at 104th Street and 57th Avenue.

The subject property is addressed as 10300 57th Avenue and is improved with a Village Water Tower and two other cellular telecommunications facilities and is located in a part of the Southeast One-Quarter of U.S. Public Land Survey Section 22, Township 1 North, Range 22 East of the Fourth Principal Meridian, lying and being in the Village of Pleasant Prairie, Kenosha County, Wisconsin and further identified as Tax Parcel Number 92-4-122-224-0111.
