

**VILLAGE OF PLEASANT PRAIRIE
NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that there will be a **PUBLIC HEARING** before the **VILLAGE PLAN COMMISSION** of the **VILLAGE OF PLEASANT PRAIRIE**, Kenosha County, Wisconsin, at the Village Hall, 9915 39th Avenue, at 6:00 P.M. on the **30th day of May, 2012**, to consider the following:

The Village of Pleasant Prairie has started the process to update the Village's Floodplain Zoning Ordinance (Section 420-131 of the Village Zoning Ordinance) to meet the minimum federal and State requirements and to adopt the revised Flood Insurance Study (FIS) and Flood Insurance Rate Map (FIRM) prepared by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) for the Village. The new FIRM Maps incorporates the Des Plaines River Watershed floodplains adopted by the Village in 1998 and other floodplain boundary amendments approved by the Village, the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources and FEMA since the last FIRM Maps were prepared for the Village and dated December 5, 1996.

The new proposed Floodplain Zoning Map and Text with detailed floodplain profiles are on file with the Village Clerk and available for viewing during regular business hours at the Village Hall, 9915 39th Avenue. In addition, the Village will be holding an **OPEN HOUSE** on **Wednesday, May 23, 2012** from **4:00 p.m. until 6:00 p.m.** where the updated FIS and FIRM's for the Village will be available for review.

ALL PERSONS INTERESTED MAY BE HEARD AT THE PUBLIC HEARING to be held at **6:00 p. m. on Wednesday, May 30, 2012** at the Village Hall, 9915 39th Avenue. Formal petitions regarding this matter may be submitted at this meeting.
