Dear Property Owner(s) and Interested Parties:

Kenosha County, with their consultant Ayres Associates, is planning to add bicycle accommodations along CTH H (88th Avenue) from the Illinois state line to STH 50. The project is 5 miles in length. The current roadway does not have shoulders wide enough to safely accommodate bicycles. The project involves widening the shoulders to provide at least 5 feet of bicycle lane in accordance with Wisconsin Bicycle Facility Design Handbook standards. Widening the shoulders will typically require the ditches to be regraded and shifted away from the roadway. Culverts may need to be extended or replaced, and intersection/driveway curb and gutter may need to be pushed out to allow room for bicycles. Construction is scheduled for 2016.

You are invited to attend a **Public Information Meeting** to be held in an open house format on **Wednesday, February 12, from 4:30 to 6:30 p.m. at LakeView Technology Academy**, located at 9449-88th Avenue, Pleasant Prairie, WI 53158.

Representatives from Kenosha County and Ayres Associates will be present to answer questions and take your comments. Persons with interest in the project are encouraged to attend.

The meeting facility is wheelchair accessible. Hearing impaired persons needing assistance may call the Wisconsin Telecommunication Relay System (dial 711). To allow time for arranging assistance, please call no later than three working days prior to the meeting.
