



NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Village Board of the Village of Pleasant Prairie, Kenosha County, Wisconsin has adopted a preliminary resolution declaring its intention to exercise its police power to levy special assessments pursuant to section 66.0703, Wis. Stats., upon property within the following proposed assessment district for benefits conferred upon the property for the construction of sanitary sewer, water main, storm sewers, sidewalks and street construction on 80th Street beginning 346 feet east of the centerline of Cooper Road and extending 233 feet west of the centerline of 57th Avenue.

A report, the estimated cost of improvements and a schedule of proposed assessments are on file at the Pleasant Prairie Village Hall, 9915 39th Avenue, Kenosha, WI and may be inspected there during any business day between the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

You are further notified that the Governing body will hear all interested persons, or their agents or attorneys, concerning matters contained in the preliminary resolution authorizing the assessments and the above-described report at 6:30 p.m. on the **19th day of May, 2008** in the Pleasant Prairie Village Hall. All objections will be considered at this hearing and thereafter the amount of the assessments will be finally determined.
