



NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS

Stats., upon property within the following proposed assessment district for benefits conferred upon the property in connection with the construction of the Sewer D Sanitary Sewer Project generally bounded by STH 50 to the north, 88th Avenue (CTH H) to the east, 93rd Place to the south and I-94 to the west .

You are further notified that the Governing body will hear all interested persons, or their agents or attorneys, concerning matters contained in the preliminary resolution authorizing the assessments and the above described report **at 6:00 p.m. on the 19th day of July, 2010** in the Pleasant Prairie Village Hall. All objections will be considered at this hearing and thereafter the amount of the assessments will be finally determined.
