


**VILLAGE OF PLEASANT PRAIRIE
NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that there will be a **PUBLIC MEETING** held at the Donald Wruck Beach Pavilion, 9999 Park Drive (west side of Lake Andrea in Prairie Springs Park) on **Monday the 26th day of April 2010, from 6:00-8:00 p.m.** of said day. The meeting will involve an Environmental Values Assessment (EVA) Workshop for the proposed Village Green Center (VGC).

In order to create sustainable design guidelines for the VGC, which will achieve the long-term vision of the community; it is critical that the Village obtain input from village staff, officials, and key stakeholders through the EVA process. The EVA is an interactive method for determining stakeholders' environmental values and putting those values into action. The EVA will be conducted in a workshop format and participants will be engaged in small group activities to explore the following four basic environmental values categories: Ecological Health, Human Health, Natural Resources, and Social Welfare. The results of the EVA will guide the direction of the sustainable elements for the VGC project and prioritize environmental goals.
