



## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS

**PLEASE TAKE NOTICE** that the Village Board of the Village of Pleasant Prairie, Kenosha County, Wisconsin has adopted a preliminary resolution declaring its intention to exercise its police power to levy special assessments pursuant to section 66.0703, Wis. Stats., upon property within the following proposed assessment district for benefits conferred upon the property for construction of 1200 linear feet of sanitary sewer in the Heritage Valley Subdivision between 105<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Sewer D, in the Village of Pleasant Prairie.

You are further notified that the Governing body will hear all interested persons, or their agents or attorneys, concerning matters contained in the preliminary resolution authorizing the assessments and the above described report **at 6:00 p.m. on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2015** in the Pleasant Prairie Village Hall. All objections will be considered at this hearing and thereafter the amount of the assessments will be finally determined.
