NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that there will be a **PUBLIC HEARING** before the **VILLAGE PLAN COMMISSION of the VILLAGE OF PLEASANT PRAIRIE**, Kenosha County, Wisconsin, at the Village Hall Auditorium, 9915 39th Avenue on the **23rd day of May 2016** on or after **6:00 p.m.** to consider the request of Jeff Lambert for Rust-Oleum Corporation for approval of a **Conditional Use Permit including Site and Operational Plans** to replace a 6,000 gallon nitrogen tank with and 11,000 bulk tank at their facility located at 8105 95th Street in LakeView Corporate Park. Nitrogen is used in the following three main processes within the facility because of its inert, safe properties: 1) to increase the safety while mixing paint batches; 2) to push plugs through the paint transfer piping lines—the plugs help clean the lines between different paint colors; and 3) to help facilitate the offloading of resins tanker trucks by slightly pressurizing the tankers.

The subject property is known as CSM 1203 and located in a part of U.S. Public Land Survey Section 21, Township 1 North, Range 22 East in the Village of Pleasant Prairie and further identified as Tax Parcel Number 92-4-122-212-0355.

ALL INTERESTED PERSONS WILL BE HEARD THE PUBLIC HEARING. Written comments will be received only prior to or at the Public Hearing. Formal petitions regarding these matters may be submitted at the public hearing.
