A CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN**, that there will be a **PUBLIC HEARING** before the **VILLAGE PLAN COMMISSION of the VILLAGE OF PLEASANT PRAIRIE**, Kenosha County, Wisconsin, at the Village Municipal Building, 9915 39th Avenue on the **26<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2015 on or after 6:00 P.M.** of said day, to consider the request of Randy Copenharve, agent for Route 165, LLC owner of the property located at 13305 104<sup>th</sup> Street for approval of a Conditional Use Permit including Site and Operational Plans for the installation of a 50foot by 72 foot open air hydrogen fuel cells storage facility enclosed with a 16 foot high precast wall panels and an ornamental fence generally located southeast of the Warehouse building (W-2) currently under construction. The fuel cells will be used to power Uline's fleet of electric forklifts as an alternative to battery powered forklifts.

The subject property is located in a part of the U.S. Public Land Survey Section 25, Township 1 North, Range 21 East, lying and being in the Village of Pleasant Prairie, Kenosha County, Wisconsin and further identified as Tax Parcel Number 91-4-121-252-0203.
