VILLAGE 2010 LAND USE PLAN MAP

In 1996, the Village adopted Community Assistance Planning Report No. 212 entitled “*A Comprehensive Plan for the Kenosha Urban Planning District*” as prepared by SEWRPC with the assistance of a Technical Advisory Committee with a few modifications.

This Plan was prepared in cooperation with the City of Kenosha, Town of Somers, Kenosha Unified School District, Kenosha County and the Village of Pleasant Prairie and represents a second generation comprehensive plan for the entire area located east of I-94 for the referenced communities until the design year of 2010. The planning effort, completed over a five (5) year time period, involved extensive inventories and analyses of the factors and conditions affecting land use and development in the area. The 1996 plan also involved the preparation of forecasts of future population, household, and economic activity levels, the formulation of community development objectives and standards, and the design of a land use plan and supporting transportation, community facility and public utility plan elements; the land use plan identified land uses and reserve land uses. Map 9-6a is the 2010 Land Use Plan Map that was in effect prior to the adoption of the 2035 Comprehensive Plan.

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
